A SHAKING IS
UNAVOIDABLE WHEN
GOD SHOWS UP

Paul and Silas simply did what they knew was best when they cast the demon out of a girl in Philippi. They lived their life in a manner that even the demons would proclaim who they served as for days, this possessed girl followed them and proclaimed that they served the true, living God. Because of their action, they were hated by the world that sought personal gain and profit. And as so many of us are familiar, they were imprisoned for their actions.

20 And when they had brought them to the magistrates, they said, "These men are Jews, and they are disturbing our city. 21 They advocate customs that are not lawful for us as Romans to accept or practice." 22 The crowd joined in attacking them, and the magistrates tore the garments off them and gave orders to beat them with rods. 23 And when they had inflicted many blows upon them, they threw them into prison, ordering the jailer to keep them safely. 24 Having received this order, he put them into the inner prison and fastened their feet in the stocks. 25 About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them, 26 and suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken. And immediately all the doors were opened, and everyone's bonds were unfastened.

In the midst of that praise, their world of stone and iron began to shake.

18 Now Mount Sinai was wrapped in smoke because the Lord had descended on it in fire. The smoke of it went up like the smoke of a kiln, and the whole mountain trembled greatly.

13 Then Jonathan climbed up on his hands and feet, and his armor-bearer after him.
